Who Are You? Living a Godly Life.

Recognising that we live our lives in multiple identities, Sam Wells will explore six identities and how each is vital. While showing and extensively illustrating what is entailed by each identity, he accepts that almost no one fulfils all six. Nonetheless, articulating the six helps surface and clarify difficult questions, like how those we greatly admire turn out to be flawed in troubling ways. Having set out the six identities, he will finally explore how these six may become an agenda for faithful living.



Revd Dr Sam Wells has been Vicar of St Martin-in-the-Fields since 2012. He has served as a parish priest for 25 years – 10 of those in urban priority areas. He also spent 7 years in North Carolina, where he was Dean of Duke University Chapel. Sam is also Visiting Professor of Christian Ethics at King's College. He is a regular contributor to Thought for the Day on BBC Radio 4's *Today* programme. He has published 44 books, including works on Christian ethics, ministry, liturgy, and preaching. Among his recent books is *Humbler Faith, Bigger God* (Eerdmans 2022).
